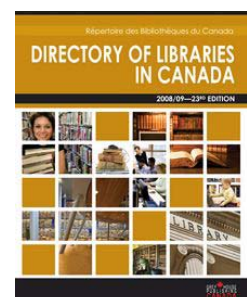
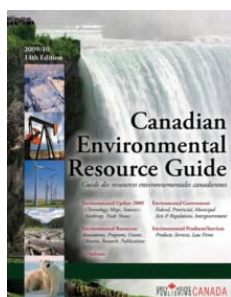
The **Canadian Publishers Collection** contains:
